A final address by Mr Roy Webb brought the evening to a close before supper was enjoyed



















With the move of the Children's Centre and Primary Years to the McKay Avenue site, the Governing Council has been involved in conversations with the Port Adelaide and Enfield Council regarding traffic management with a view that child safety is our priority. The following will be in place from the first day of term

McKay Avenue will remain divided by the chicane, traffic restrictions that do not allow traffic to pass through the chicane will remain. We ask that all parents continue to obey this restriction.

Two kiss and drop areas (one on each side of the chicane) will operate around drop off and pick up times.

Restricted parking will operate on other areas of McKay Avenue during pick up and drop off times. Non-restricted parking will available on Brecon St, Seymour Ave and Danby Ave.

There are two bus zones along McKay Avenue that restrict parking, these restrictions should be obeyed.

During the first couple of weeks of Term 1 a Traffic Management Engineer from PAEC will observe traffic and pedestrian activity with a view that a school crossing will be put in place should there be a need.

We ask that all parents and caregivers obey the traffic controls, ensuring the safety of the students.
