# Year 6/7

This term has seen the year 6/7 class conducting some experiments. One that they particularly enjoyed was seeing if we can turn a raw egg into a bouncy egg using only vinegar.

This is what we discovered:

Egg shell is made of **calcium carbonate**. Vinegar is an acid - **acetic acid**. When calcium carbonate is exposed to an acid it reacts. The calcium carbonate egg shell dissolves, but the membrane inside the shell, surrounding the egg, remains intact.

This makes the egg feel rubbery.



We put the egg in vinegar, added some dye and left it for 2 days.



They do actually look and feel like rubber balls!

Students held them from a height of about 10cm and let them drop. It worked, they bounced! Higher than that was not quite as successful!
